Socially Responsible Procurement Duties

General duties:

- To improve the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of its area by carrying out public procurement in a socially responsible way, in accordance with the sustainable development principle
- Prepare strategy, and set and publish objectives
- Provisions must be proportionate
- Requirements on "prescribed contracts" (major construction contracts and outsourcing services contracts)

Major construction contracts:

- Social Public Works Clauses
- Contract management to ensure implementation
- Exception reporting if clauses not used
- Ensure obligations are implemented throughout the supply chain

Outsourcing services contracts:

- Revised Workforce Code
- Social Public Workforce Clauses
- Contract management to ensure implementation
- Exception reporting if clauses not used
- Ensure obligations are implemented throughout the supply chain

Reporting and accountability:

- Prepare and publish annual report, including a review
- Summary of procurements carried out over the year and expected to carry out over the next two years
- · Contracts register
- Investigations can be carried out by Welsh Ministers
- Procurement sub-group to review annual reports and exception notifications
